

POSSIBLE Little Treasures Preschool At-Home Learning Plan 2021-2022

We are excited to have in-person learning available at Little Treasures, but understand that some families may prefer that their children stay home during this uncertain time. If your child has been accepted to our program, and if you prefer at-home learning, we will share weekly lesson plans and learning activities that can be received electronically or picked up at the preschool. **The curriculum will mirror our in-school learning.**

THE DETAILS:

Our highly-qualified at-home teacher will be **Cynthia Price**, who has taught Pre-Kindergarten students at Little Treasures since 2011. She's awesome! Mrs. Price will stay in constant contact and will be available to help you with your little one's learning.

Parents who sign up for at-home learning will agree to be “engaged in the educational process” - read and respond to messages, watch short learning videos, help with assessment (may include checklists, photos, examples of child's work), and help their child with learning activities. Your input will be important as your child will be accounted for in Little Treasures' district and state reporting requirements.

ADVANTAGES TO AT-HOME LEARNING:

- 1) Your child will stay engaged in learning.
- 2) Your child will have a preschool “slot” at Little Treasures, so if conditions improve and you would like them to join a Little Treasures class at a later date, that will be an option. We would prefer that they join a class on a set date – November 3rd, January 6th, or February 17th.
- 3) We will provide learning materials and a two-time credit for books at Scholastic.com.
- 4) At-home learning can be quite flexible so you and your child can engage in learning activities at a time that works best for your family.
